## Unifrog tasks

**CV:** fill the sections in on Unifrog and then export it to Word to edit it and make it stand out. Unifrog has lots of tips on each stage of writing your CV.

**Courses:** Unifrog has a range of online courses students can take in three areas

- ✓ **Careers and virtual work experience:** Help students explore careers (eg 'How to start a business'), do virtual work experience (eg a course where students experience being an architect by designing a structure for animals), and develop career readiness skills (eg a course on how to behave in the workplace).
- ✓ **Subject tasters:** Give students an idea of what studying a particular subject is like, (e.g. a course giving students a taste of studying maths at university: 'The Size of Infinity').
- ✓ **PSHE and life skills:** Help students develop as people and citizens (e.g. a course on how to set goals and write plans).

### **What is Unifrog?**

Unifrog is a one-stop-shop where students can explore their interests, then find and successfully apply for their next best step after school. It brings together every step of the process, from students exploring interests, to recording skills, to finding and comparing apprenticeship and university courses, to submitting applications.
