

RESULTS SUMMER 2025

Dear Student,

We do hope that you are pleased with your results.

If any of your results are below expectations, you should consider the options below. However, before you decide to do anything, **talk the situation through with the relevant subject staff**, as they will be able to guide you. The Sixth Form team will be available to speak to you on results day and the day after.

1. Photocopy of Script - You can send for a **photocopy** of your script for any component or unit either to check whether it would be worth asking for a review of marking or to see where you could improve by resitting the paper – prior authorisation will be required from the student.

2. Review of Marking - You can ask for a **review of marking** of one or more of your papers. You should discuss this with your subject teacher first.

3. Priority Review of Marking - If your university place depends on the result you can apply for a **Priority review of marking Deadline 21st August**. Awarding bodies strongly advise candidates and/or the centre to inform their University/College that a review of results has been requested. By informing them, they **may** be able to keep the candidates place open until the review has been completed.

4. Re-Sits. - You can **re-sit** some qualifications. Resits will generally be in June 2026, and there also are resits for English Language and Maths GCSE in early November 2025. Your subject teachers will want to talk this through with you before any decisions are made. You should confirm with the Exams Office whether your course is still eligible for resitting.

To apply for a post-results enquiry, complete the form attached and take it to the Exams Office. **Requests will only be submitted on receipt of payment via Scopay or card.**

You will be charged for Paper 1, as that had an outcome with no grade change. You will not be charged for Paper 2, as that had an outcome directly resulting in a grade change.
